


Purple Route Extension to University Parkway

# **CCC** History

- In 2007 the City commissioned the BMC to conduct a study to determine feasibility and potential ridership of a downtown shuttle.
  - Recommendations
    - 4 routes
    - Water Shuttle
    - Fare Free
  - ➤ Mayor and Council adjusted the parking tax to fund the effort December 2008.
  - > Harbor Connector launched November 2009.
  - ➤ Orange Route launched in January 2010.
  - Purple, Green, Banner between June 2010 and June 2012.

# Extension of the Purple Route

- Operates Within CCC Parameters
- Meets Community Needs/Desires
- Eliminates Need to Transfer to Another Bus to get Beyond Penn Station
- The communities of Charles Village, Charles North, Old Goucher, Barclay and Remington would be tied into the CCC's route structure.
- This extension would provide easy access to the Charm City Circulator's Harbor Connector and on to Canton or Tide Point.
- The Fast, Friendly, Frequent, and Fare-Free system will encourage those who would typically drive around the downtown area to use the CCC (Choice Riders).

## **Extension Details**

#### Current Route

- Takes 56 minutes to complete;
- Requires 6 buses;
- Covers 6.54 miles from Federal Hill to Penn Station;
- Serves 2.3 million annual and 45,000 weekly riders;
- Serves Federal Hill, Inner Harbor, City Center, Historic Mount Vernon;

### Route Adjustment

- Will extend the Purple Route by 3.3 miles making the route a total of 9.8 miles;
- Will require an additional 22 minutes to complete;
- Will have 13 additional stops.

Northbound Extension on Charles Street – 7 stops (All current MTA stops).

22<sup>nd</sup> Street Old Goucher

25<sup>th</sup> Street Sankofa World Bazaar

27<sup>th</sup> Street Remington, Charles Village, School of Ed.

31<sup>st</sup> Street Museum of Art

• 33<sup>rd</sup> Street JHU

University Parkway Charles North

At the end of the route the bus would turn right on University Parkway and continue southbound on St. Paul Street.

- Install signage (Fall 2014)
- Install benches/shelters (Fall 2014 to Spring 2015);
- Adjustments to Next Bus annunciation/GPS (Fall 2014);
- Revise Maps, Brochures to reflect the route adjustment (Summer/Fall 2014);
- Adjustments to Web Site, Mobile Apps, Social Media;
- Begin operations (Fall 2014)
